

HOW TO OBTAIN NEW IDENTIFICATION FOR A MINOR

TO GET A NEW BIRTH CERTIFICATE:

- Contact the Department of Health in the State where you were born.
- If you were born in Tennessee –
A certified copy of the court order; original birth certificate and a check or money order for \$15.00 should be sent to: TN Vital Records, Central Services Bldg., 5th Avenue North, 1st Floor, Nashville, TN 37247
- It usually takes 3-4 weeks to receive your new birth certificate.
- If you wish to speak with someone, call (615) 741-1763 Amendment Unit.
- The website is www.tn.gov/health.

TO GET A NEW SOCIAL SECURITY CARD:

- Go to any local Social Security office
- Call (800) 772-1213 to request an application, you should receive it in the mail within 2 weeks.
- The web address is www.socialsecurity.gov.
- There is no charge for a new social security card.

TO GET A NEW DRIVER'S LICENSE:

- Take a certified copy of the court order to a driver testing center.
- The hours of operation are Monday – Friday 8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- There is a \$8.00 charge for this service.
